We again will have a variety of shows and demonstrations on wool crafts, a used equipment sale, craft sales tables, a fiber arts contest and workshops.

Fleece and Fiber Show

Fleeces entered for judging will be judged by Amy Wolf starting at 9am on Saturday April 6th. Amy is a regionally respected wool judge. A fleece sale will be held on Saturday immediately on completion of judging and will continue until Sunday 4/7 4pm. A silent auction of best of class fleeces will be held on Saturday 4/6 starting at 3pm and concluding at 4pm. All entries will be sifted for soundness and must be shown unwashed.

- Fibers must be North American grown during the past year.
- Sheep and goat fleeces shall be whole and skirted appropriately.
- Rabbit fur shall be 1 oz. or more per entry.
- Llama, alpaca fleeces shall consist of the whole "blanket". Other fibers shall be 5 oz. or more.

Used Equipment Sale

- We are again offering used equipment for sale: spinning wheels, looms, carders, fitting stands, clippers, etc.
- Sale items must be brought in according to the "haul-in" schedule shown below. Sale tags will be provided. The seller will pay a 10% sales fee. Sales tax will also be collected. All items not sold must be removed between 3pm and 4pm, Sunday, April 7th. Items not picked up will become property of the Western Washington Sheep and Fleece Shows. All items must be in useable working order. Please review the rules for condition of the items.

Craft Tables

- For the sale of processed wool and other natural fiber-related items and not used equipment.
- Raw fibers must not be sold from the Craft Tables.
- Priority will be given to new US produced products.
- All booths are 10' X 10', Tables are \$5 each.

Workshops will be conducted as described on our website. Sign-up by March 20th.

Fiber Arts Contest - Hand made by entrant of primarily hand spun fibers. See our website for details.

- Entries accepted April 5th, 6– 9pm. Entries released April 7th, at 4pm.

FIBER WORKSHOPS

Nuno Felted Scarf.....Saturday, 9 am to 12pm

Instructor: Beth Lanning

Come join us and create your very own, one-of-a-kind, Nuno felt scarf. You will learn the art of wet felting starting with a silk scarf base and layering merino wool blended with silk to make a unique scarf. This is a beginner friendly class, no experience needed. We will have multiple wool colors to choose from for your scarf. At the end of the class, you will have a completed scarf to wear! Please bring 2 beach towels with you. Maximum 10 students. Class fee \$30.

All-In-One Beginning Rug HookingSaturday, 1pm to 4pm

Rug hooking goes back hundreds of years, and in that time, folks learned how to hook rugs that would last for generations, from the supplies they already had on hand. Students in this class will get a chance to sample a variety of materials that can be used in rug hooking; yarn, T-shirt strips, wool fabric strips, and cotton fabric strips, so they can go home, take a look at their stash, and say, "Yup, I can hook a rug with that!" Kit and hook provided. Students should bring scissors and wear long pants. Maximum 20 students. Class fee: \$30, Materials fee: \$30.

Spinning the Breeds.....Sunday, 10am to 1pm

This year's class will focus on the Bluefaced Leicester and how the wool industry has used this breed to up-grade both the fleece and confirmation of many of our purebred flocks. This is a unique look at each of these breeds and how they cross with the BFL. Shetland, Shetland Mule, Romney, Romney Mule, Border Leicester, and Border Leicester Mule.

Goat Milk Soap Making.....Sunday, 1pm to 4pm

Learn how to make Cold Process Soap and make approximately 2 pounds of soap. You will receive your own mold and all the supplies to create a block of soap. A variety of scents will be available to customize your batch. Take home your soap to cure and a recipe to make it again. Maximum 20 students.
